

\*\*Caution\*\* May cause daydreaming about taking a vacation in Italy. :-I have been buying the "365 Days in Italy" calendars for about 10 years now. There are a lot of great reasons to get this calendar, and not just for the art.1) The calendar is large. There is plenty of room in each date's box to write little notes about doctor appointments, what time to pick the kids up from soccer, etc., etc.2) The top fold of the monthly calendar gives a little information about the location featured that month. Sometimes it might be some of the history of the region or city, sometimes the famous people who were born there, sometimes travel tips.3) The art...the photographs. WOW! I actually save the calendars from the previous years because the photographs are so nice and well done. Some of them are famous landmarks, some are pictures of a field of sunflowers (yeah, that's a big

thing in Tuscany), but they're all of the highest quality. I've been to Italy, and I really love it. These calendars and all the amazing photos not only remind me of the wonderful times I've had in Italy with my family, they also inspire me to search out those less-frequented spots and side streets on my next visit.

Very pretty! It's nice having 30-ish pictures to look at every month. They are smaller photos, of course, but still beautiful & easy to see the details. I will probably buy more of these calendars in the future. I like having a couple different ones in the house, in different rooms. These calendars are perfect for that. I like the variety.

I ordered this calendar after my first (and hopefully not last!) trip to Italy in 2012. It now seems to have become an annual tradition for me to order this. I've visited a lot of the places but many I've never heard of. It's just nice to relive and to dream of a future visit. I hang this in my kitchen as a decorating piece. If you want to write appts, there's plenty of room for that, too. The photos are assembled beautifully, and there are rarely repeats. (Seriously though, how can you not want to look at the Duomo in Florence again?) I recommend this calendar for a little taste of Italy in your life. :)

Better than I expected. Get to experience a different part of Italy each month, in the large photo and in the small ones each day. Has a little bit of history or information regarding the area. After going to Italy, this is a must, brings back so many memories to the places we saw.

I get one every year. Each month features a different city or province with a description and small map showing its location. Photography's not just landscapes; it's local culture. I feel bad "trashing" (recycling!) such amazing images when the year's done, but the nice thing is there'll be a new calendar.

Bellissima! I love the Page A Day calendars, whether desktop or wall. The photos are beautiful, the printing is clear, the setup is convenient if you want to write in the date squares. I'm hooked. But then, I've been hooked for years. (The seller shipped quickly, and packaging was good, as well.)

Meh, to my surprise I am not a huge fan of this calendar. I adore Italy and the pictures are great, but there's just too much going on. Having a picture for every day makes for an overly busy calendar. It's hard to immediately see my notes/events for specific dates because the pictures and other

wording is distracting. It's only March and I'm not sure I'll be able to last the whole year with this one. Just not my cup of tea I guess.

I thought I read wrong, but there really are pictures for every day in the year! I expected a lovely, large monthly picture, but this unique calendar has that as well as a smaller picture above each day. Mini visits to places I've been and to yet undiscovered regions of Italia. Beautiful!
