

I knew that, as a Geisel Award winner, this would be at least a passable book (I sometimes disagree with the awards, after all), but I was actually pleasantly surprised by the story. I think I associate the Geisel Award books with extra silliness, but this is not only a very realistic book, but it also manages to still remain quite funny.Mo is the smallest player on his football team. During a game, his coach decides to take advantage of the other team's dismissive attitude to run a little play and play a little trick.Some parents complain that their children refuse to read books which are too "girly," and this book would be a good offering to get them reading. But, of course, do try to broaden their horizons

and break down those norms! In the meantime, though, if you just need to get them reading, this is a great pick for lovers of sports and more true-life type stories.
