I am really enjoying the series of Little Golden Books. If you have all the other seven depicting the Saga (and I would recommend them too), and the "I am.." series (Pilot, Droid, Sith, Jedi) you must buy this one. The stylized illustrations are similar to all the rest of the Little Golden Book series, and the focus naturally is on Princess Leia. The "girl power" message is subtle but well-presented. This would be a great gift for a young girl to encourage her interest in Star Wars. Star Wars is not just for boys! As an adult Star Wars collector, I am finding The Little Golden Book series to be delightful as well. Recommended!
