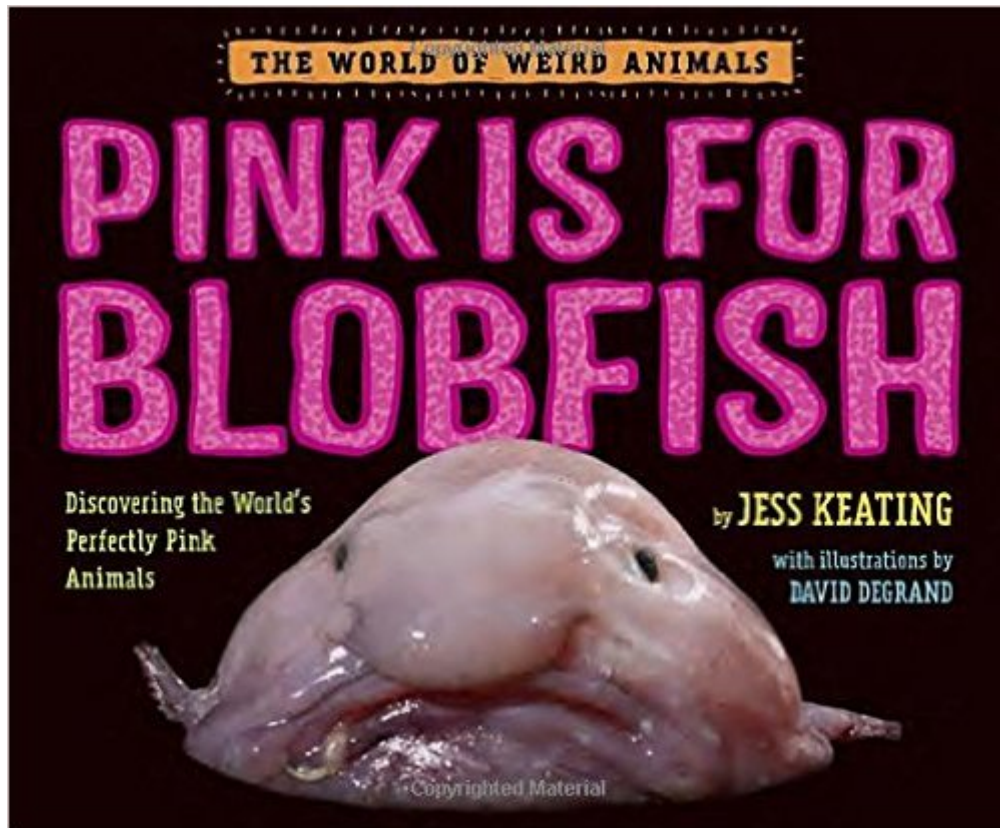

Summary: If your list of pink animals begins and ends with a flamingo, you need to take a look at this book. And if you think pink is a dainty, girly-girl color, check out the photos of the pinktoe tarantula and the dragon millipede. Not to mention the blobfish, recently voted the ugliest animal in the world by the Ugly Animal Preservation Society. Each two-page spread includes a full-page

photo and the name, species name, size, diet, habitat, predators and threats, and some fun facts. End matter includes a glossary, list of further resources, and a color-coded map that shows where each animal lives. Pros: A unique approach to animal facts, written in an easy-to-read format that kids will enjoy. This is the first in a series called "The World of Weird Animals". Cons: I found the map a little difficult to use.

My 4th graders couldn't get enough of this book! Keating found some of the most interesting (and sometimes 'grossest'!) animals to write about in this book. It really got us thinking about the little-known animals in our world.

This book is amazing! As a teacher I love this book to spark creativity and higher level thinking. Students are drawn to learning about animals and this book is incredibly engaging. As a mom I love this book, because it's a great book to initiate conversation. Each page has a striking photograph of the animal, a comic-like illustration of the animal, and three types of text (an overview, fun fact, and encyclopedia-like information).
