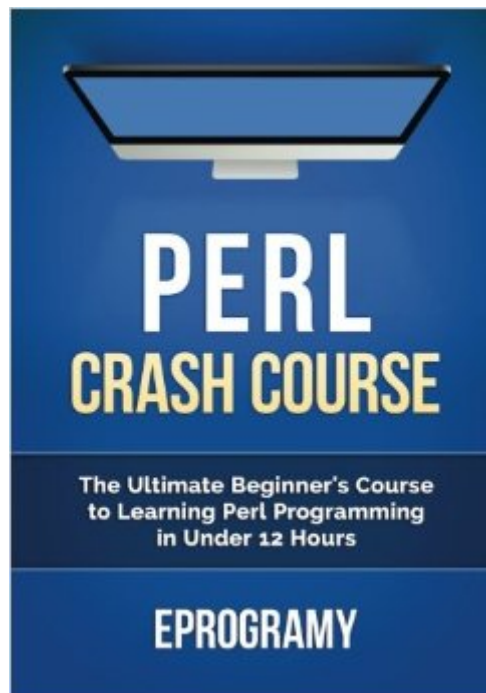

many errors in this book. The author confound byte code compiling (C#, JAVA) and interpreted languages. Only a line about regular Expressions ... Seriously? The examples of "class /object" use is irrelevant. Not a concrete example of what makes perl a great language "file data processing and report creation" Sure in the introduction PERL is painted to be Practical Extracting and Reporting Language but in the rest of the book there is nothing around that theme!

I was extremely disappointed in this book. It is riddled with mistakes in the plain English portion of the book. In the first paragraph of the first chapter alone I counted 9 grammar or sentence structure mistakes. On the first page of the first chapter I counted 21 total. Seriously? You are going to sell a book claiming to teach someone a new programming language when you yourself don't even understand English? I cannot believe that anyone would think it is okay to charge other people \$10 for a book like this. I tried to continue on with the book and give it a chance, thinking that at least the code written in the book would be correct, but I have no idea if it is or not because 1) If they can't write English correctly then why should I trust they wrote PERL correctly? and 2) the grammar mistakes make the code hard to understand. I'm not sure what the code is supposed to do at some parts because I couldn't understand their explanation of it. I tried to fight through the first couple chapters (which is all in plain English, no programming). When I got to the programming explanations and examples I had to say no more. I was wasting my time because I was spending more time trying to understand what they wrote in English rather than spending time learning PERL. COMPLETE WASTE OF TIME.

I tried to give this book a chance. The grammar is poor. Sentences are poorly written and there are numerous run on sentences. I found that I was constantly trying to decipher what the writer was saying rather than learning the material.

This one is plain simple what it says. A real good crash course of how to use Perl. As I also liked EPROGRAMY's course about Java I was curious if this one would match my expectations either? And yes it does. The course has a clear, logic structure and the same awesome mix of explaining a new term and giving you an easy to understand example afterwards. I found it most effective - using these examples straight away to see and understand what happens. Good Course and Perl is a

good additional 'Tool' to sharpen and strengthen my programming skills.

This is the first time that I have read something about Perl Programming. And this is one comprehensive and thorough book that has discussed so many important things about it. It has discussed what it is, its history, how to install it, the different Perl variables, references, operators, and so much more! This book is really the ultimate guide book on Perl Programming and must be read by everyone in this serious side of programming. There are some mistakes here and there that can be quite misleading at times. Some of the scripts aren't complete but more or less pseudo code that requires you to actually look at your syntax closely because the text will miss out a few semicolons. It's a great exercise book

I bought this book for \$0.99 and I wasn't sure that I would get a lot of it but boy, did I. It is exactly what it says, a crash-course in PERL. I already know a little coding from javascript and I think that helped me with the pace of the book and I really appreciated how no-nonsense it was.
