Synopsis

Flannery O'Connor once was on the news as a child showing everyone how she had trained a chicken to walk backwards. She was a strong willed fowl enthusiast with a knack for opening people's eyes to forgiveness. As an adult she surrounded herself with a massive collection of ducks, swans, Guinea hens, and peacocks. She wrote stories that, "un-hid people's ugly, mean parts and proved that everybody - even preachers and grandmothers - needs to be forgiven". In the story, "The King of the Birds" Acree Graham Macam introduces us to a story inspired by Flannery's childhood. We meet a little girl who has taught a chicken to walk backwards. After all of the fame has worn away Flannery feels like life is too quiet. Flannery believes that by adding more birds to her

collection that that would do the trick, however it does the opposite. She decides to add a peacock to her flock and make him the king of all the birds. When the "king" arrived she placed a crown on his head and he did not feel like showing off his beautiful feathers. Flannery threw the peacock a party, let him play in a fig tree, let him feast of flowers, and even threw him a parade in his honor. No matter what she did she could not make the "king" show his beautiful plumage. You will have to pick up this story on September 1st to find out if the "king" ever shows his tail feathers and if anyone ever felt quiet again. @astoryaday
