

This is one of those books that i never thought i would buy. mainly because i prefer to buy encyclopedias on dinosaurs. But after reading this book in the store, I can confidently say that this is one of the most beautiful resources you can give your child when introducing him to facts about feathered dinosaurs. All but two of the animals in this book are covered in feathers (thoguh some scientists argue that one of these two should be feathered anyways), and it makes it clear that Birds evolved from Dinosaurs. Each animal is anatomically accurate (except for pronated wrists on some of the creatures), and in some cases, there colors reflect what is known from the fossils. The one thing that stuck out to me with this book is the art work, which reminds me of some of the old dinosaur books i used to check out in elementary school. The Artwork is very beautiful, and looks a lot better then some of the digital works featured in today's dinosaur Encyclopedias. Overall, i can totally recommend this book to anyone who has an interest in the subject. And it is a lot better then

some of the other non encyclopedic dinosaur books I saw at the stores.
