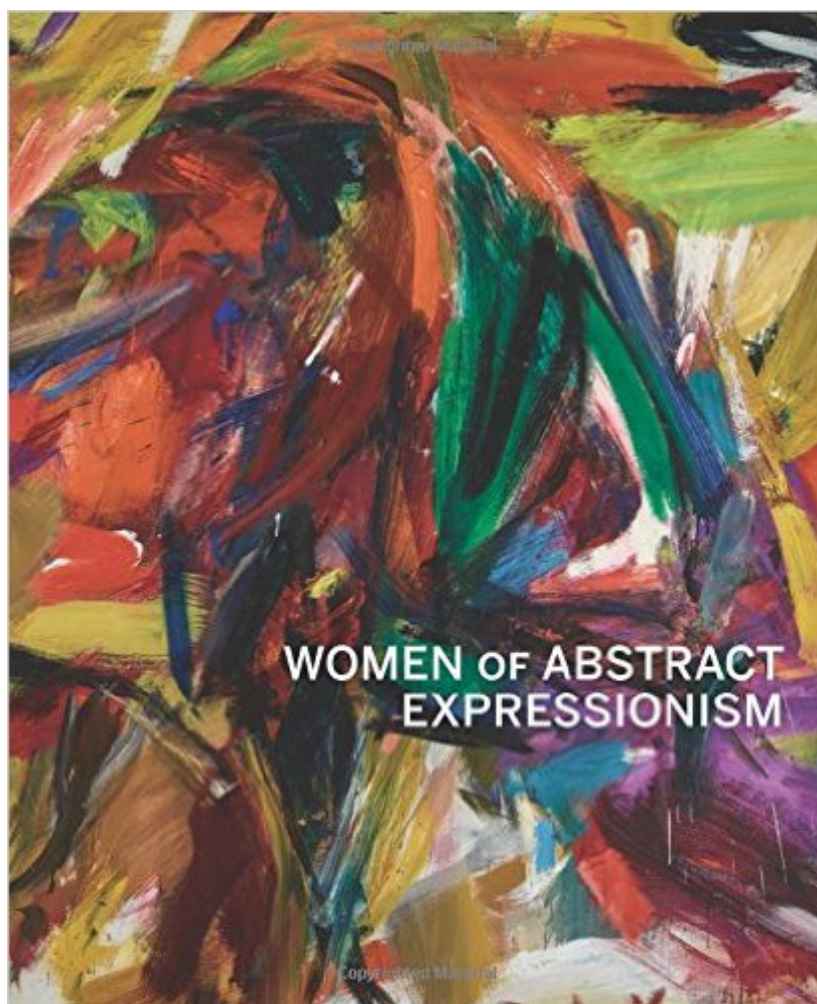

It does this I believe, but it could have said more about the artists later working life. the only qualm with the book I have is the second rather wordy art forum styled piece. it may have been well meaning to art historians and I do not believe in dummying down, but this was way off

base for anyone that may be a layman of sorts trying to learn. Now on to the work. Of course I wish there were more pictures, of the work and of the artists, of the time. The differences in work and sexual politics between East and West may have made a very strong photographic essay since it was referred to many times in the book. Over all, I loved the book.

This book accompanies an exhibit of the same name at the Denver Art Museum running through September 25, 2016. The reproductions of the pieces are excellent, and the book does a fine job of providing backgrounds for the works by way of biographies of the artists and some history of the times. Worth buying if you're at all interested in this genre and period of art. And if you can make it to Denver to see the works in person, do so.
