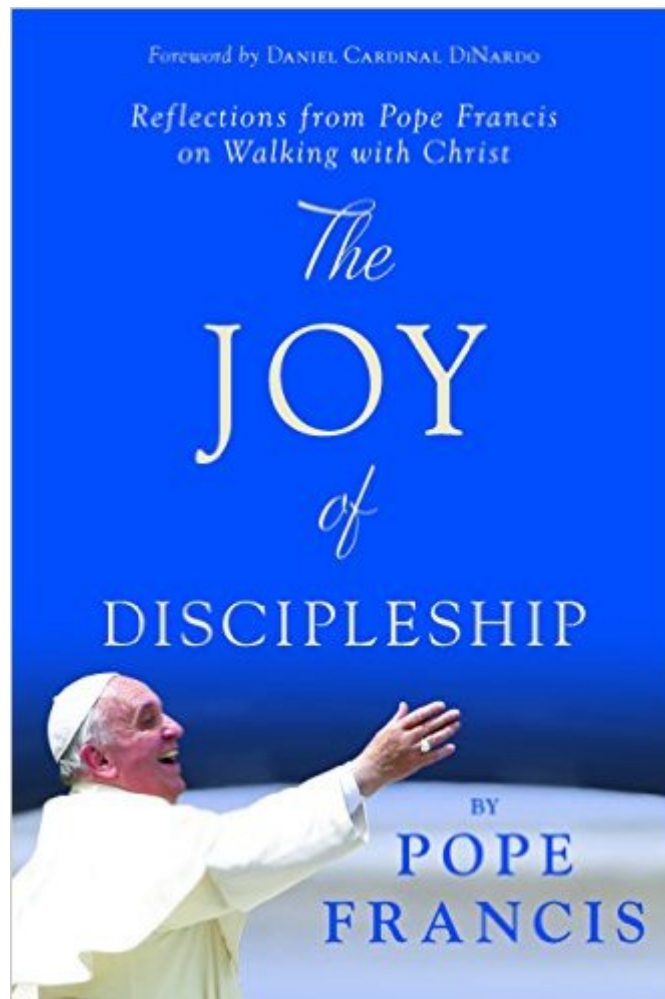

"The Joy of Discipleship" by Pope Francis is a refreshing and inspiring work by the pontiff beckoning the reader into living his or her faith, with the promise that Joy will be a part of this. This book is, for lack of a better word, pasted together from a series of sermons given by his Holiness. The reading of it is extremely accessible and one that can be read more than once so that the theme is inwardly digested. The basic premise is perhaps that we should do unto others, that which has been done unto us. The author reminds us that through Jesus' sacrifice our sins are forgiven and mercy has been shown upon us, so that we now need to reflect the same to others. This is to be accomplished by as individuals and by members of the one body known as God's church. Never afraid to jump across denomination lines Pope Francis reminds the reader that even in Islam the attributes given to the Creator include "merciful and kind" and we can and should reflect that ourselves. He reminds us that though it is easy to be loving and kind to those who offer the same to us, these very gifts are to be shared Christ-like - to those who do not offer the same. Thus, the name he gives those who are willing to take this risk - "Courageous Christians." Taking the Courageous Christian path is a serious one that, if risked by the faithful, leads to joy (hence the title of the book)! The author goes on to dissect the theme a bit more with references from St. Paul and always looking to Jesus as our model, especially when courage is needed. Of course, Jesus is encountered regularly by biblical reading, worship, in the Eucharist and by the service of the Holy Spirit.
