

It's been a long time since the Ghostbusters were a trending topic in society, but they are back full force but with some changes! In stead of the original cast including Dan Aykroyd, Bill Murray, and the others, this time the Ghostbusters are women! Melissa McCarthy and Kristen Wiig are wonderful actresses and super funny and totally fit the personas in this book! I haven't seen the new movie yet but that doesn't matter. This book will give you insight into the characters, the science and history behind it as well as how to become your own Ghostbuster, with a side of humor! Right from the start, from reading the New Foreword and Introduction, which at first made me skeptical of what I was about to read, you can see that this book is serious about not being too serious. This is not your typical identification textbook. It could be like a textbook with lots of information, and tips, but it is written differently and so that even the less scholarly person could understand it. Ghost From Our Past is a quick read. Seriously. I literally read the whole book this weekend while on a trip to my family's house. It was a 7 hour drive, each way, with stops for food and gas and leg stretching with my husband and 3 kids. I read the book about a quarter of the way there and 75% of the way back and finished it. I couldn't put it down. One thing you should know is that this book is written in perspective of the two leading women of the new Ghostbusters movie, and sometimes it seems if they refer to themselves in third person but not in a weird way, as it fits humorously.
