

Some of my fondest memories of childhood revolve around coloring. I would use crayons, paint, markers, pencils â “ whatever was handy. I colored in books, on plain paper and even on the occasional canvas that my mother gifted me. As I grew older, I grew out of that â “ or simply found other mediums to express myself. But not that â ^Adult Coloringâ ™ is in, Iâ ™ve rediscovered it and Iâ ™m wondering why I ever stepped away. The term â ^adult coloringâ ™ may seem odd, even demeaning, but it really specifies what â ^kindâ ™ of books they are. These are not your average kids coloring book with simple lines and easy illustrations â “ no, these are complicated and swirling patterns that allow your mind to wander and find calm as you pen flies across the page. This one, â ^Inktangle 2.0â ™ is a combination book, both designed as a coloring book and as an icon hunt. While I havenâ ™t pursued the icon part of it, I have seen them speckled across the pages and I could see how these would be interesting to some. I am more enthralled with the illustrations themselves. Echoâ ™s of mandala with hints of modern design, each is different and stand alone. I found the coffee (or it could be tea) cup one and decided it was the first one I HAD to color. The thick paper stood up to the sharpies well, and while it bled through to the back of the page, it

didn't bleed to the next page " and since these are single sided pictures, it worked out perfectly. I humbly offer pictures of my effort.

Love this book. I like the difficulty and intricacy in it. This book is not for the faint at heart. There is a lot of details within the designs which provides a lot of room for color. I recommend this book for the intermediate and advance.

Inktangle is a gorgeous coloring book made for adults. The designs are intricate, creating beautiful works of art that will take time. It's so relaxing "you can lose yourself in simply filling it the blocks with your ink or crayons. In addition to being a coloring book, Inktangle is also an activity book where you can engage in searching for hidden pop icons "which is actually quite difficult. I purchased the downloadable version, so I can print and reprint the pages as many times as I want, but I understand that the paper version is made of nice, heavy paper, which would be suitable for anyone who would like to frame their works of art. I was extremely pleased with this book "I also paint and draw, but sometimes I just love to color. It's not just for kids anymore!

I am so glad adult coloring books are a thing now. This book offers the coloring enthusiast some beautiful and intricate designs. Even just looking at the illustrations is like a cool breeze of pure Zen goodness. Coloring them gives you that utterly delicious emotional state of mind-body connection. The illustrations tend to have an organic flow to them, but there are lovely patterns within the organic structure. My second-favorite illustration was #44, which is a fun cupcake design. But hands-down my favorite was #52 because it's floral and has other nature-inspired shapes, and the whole thing somehow comes together and looks like a rooster! Well, I don't know if it's supposed to be a rooster, but that is what jumped out at me, and it made me smile!

Very interesting book! In addition to the intricate coloring pages, you have the opportunity to hunt for various hidden icons. When you find them, a puzzle is decoded! The only problem I found is that some pages are drawn with very heavy black lines and will surely use a lot of ink to print.
