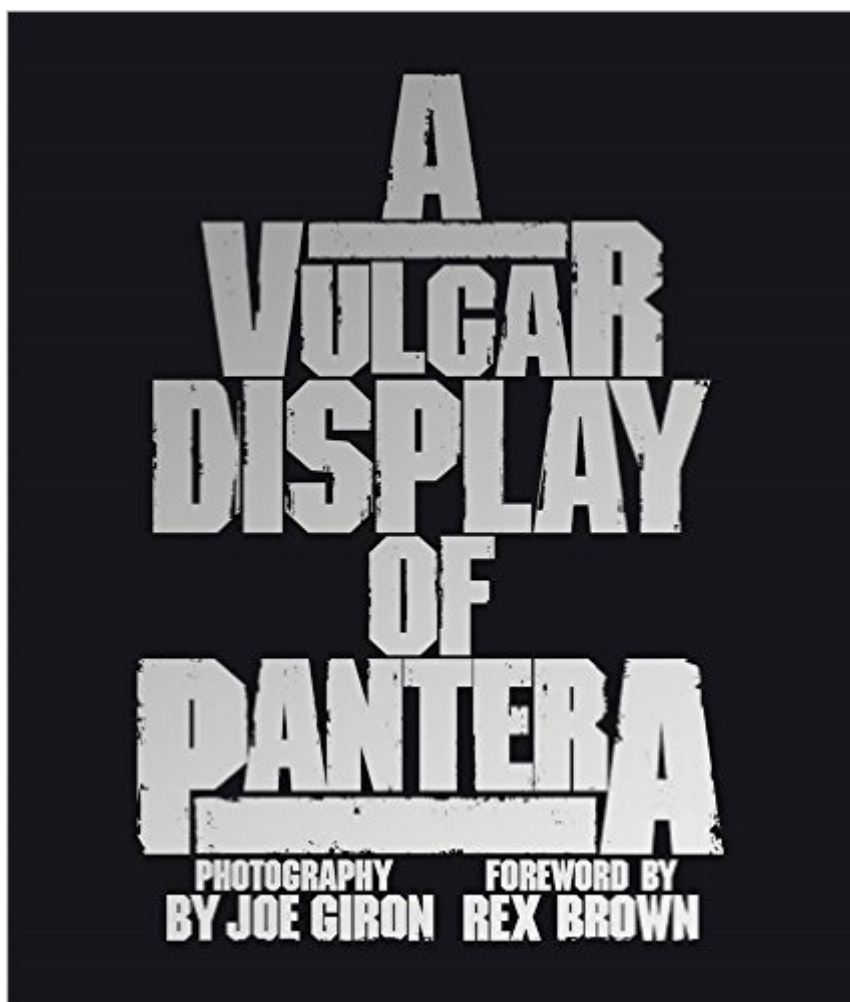

Rex Brown was born in 1964 in Graham, Texas. He joined Pantera in 1982 and has also played with Down. His new band, Kill Devil Hill, is climbing the charts. He is the author of *Official Truth*, *101 Proof: The Inside Story of Pantera*. He lives in New Mexico.

I never said Japan wasn't the last show. It surely was. Joe says they played Tacoma and one more show in Canada before their last show in Japan. They actually played 4 total shows in Canada after Tacoma. Believe me, I know my Pantera.
